

## **GeoScienceWorld Adds *Russian Geology and Geophysics* to its Prestigious Journals Collection**

Published by Novosibirsk State University, the journal publishes original articles of theoretical and methodological nature in all fields of geology, geophysics, and geochemistry. This includes research results on: field investigations and modeling of the composition and structure of the Earth's crust and mantle; processes of formation and general structure patterns of ore minerals resources and oil and gas fields; application of exploration methods and development of deposits; theoretical and practical aspects of biosphere evolution; environment and climate change. The Journal also reports results of regional investigation of the geology of Siberia and adjacent territories - priority is usually given to these papers.
